Magic Comes to More House!



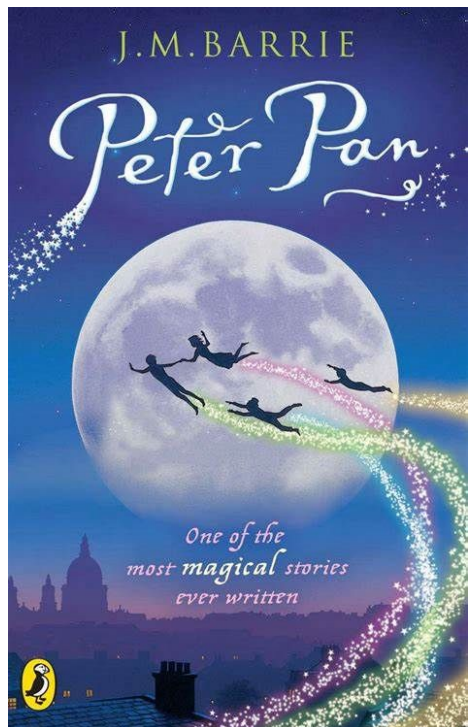
